The 2006 North West Regional Structural Awards

The Awards will be presented by the Lancashire & Cheshire Branch of the Institution of Structural Engineers at the Branch Annual Dinner in March.

Award Categories

There will be four Awards, three for different sizes of projects and one for a project constructed outside the North West. There will be two Commendations for projects with particular qualities as outlined below.

Awards:

'Small', 'Medium' and 'Large'

Any size of project is eligible. The judges will decide the category to which a submission will be entered.

'Project constructed outside the North West'

Any size of project is eligible but it must be designed by an Engineer in the North West.

Commendations:

'Best Sustainable Project'

In line with the Institution's guidance on sustainable construction.

'Most Innovative Project'

In line with the Movement for Innovation guidance.

Who Can Submit Entries?

Submissions are invited from all organisations within the boundaries of the Branch. The structural design must have been predominantly carried out by a member of the Branch of any grade (Graduate, Associate Member, Member or Fellow) and entries are particularly sought from small practices.

Closing date for submissions:

Monday 10th October 2005

NB: The copyright of all work submitted remains with the authors, but the Institution reserves the right to retain work for exhibition purposes and to reproduce it for publication, including digital publication. If the copyright of any image belongs to another party, this must be indicated. Award winners will be responsible for obtaining permission to publish images.

Criteria and Style of Submissions

To qualify for entry to the Awards, the following simple criteria must be met:

- The structure must be completed in the calendar year of 2005.
- The structure must be located within the boundaries of the Branch (unless the Award is for a project constructed outside the North West).

Your submission should be in the form of a single-sided A1 poster printed and mounted on 5mm foamex using the submission header*, together with a CD containing five photographs of the project (at any stage of the construction), saved as high resolution jpgs. Your submission poster should include the following:

- The name of the engineer and practice responsible for the structural design.
- Name the client and other professionals involved in the project (e.g. Architect, Quantity Surveyor, Main Contractor, Steelwork Contractor, etc)
- At least one colour photograph of the project.
- A description of the structural form, its intended use, dimensions and form of contract used for procurement.
- Salient details which make the structure an award winner.
- Information on sustainability, if this is to be considered.
- Information on innovation, if this is to be considered.

* A Submission header provided by the branch must be used on the A1 poster. An eps file or other format can be requested via email to: admin@istructe.com

Why Enter?

The Award winners will benefit from the following:

- A certificate presented to the named engineer by the President of the Institution
- A certificate for each of the project team and the named Engineer's organisation.
- All A1 posters will be displayed at the Annual Dinner
- The Award winners and their project will be featured in The Structural Engineer.
- Photographs of the Award Winners and details of the winning projects will be sent to the Press.
- Submissions to the regional awards also fulfil the criteria for the national awards. You may wish to consider also submitting your entry to the National Awards.
